At the outset the Chairman, SUGC, welcomed all the members present, and subsequently, the agenda was taken up for discussion.

# Item No. 1: Consideration of the appeals of those students whose academic programs have been terminated at the end of 2016-17-II and earlier semesters due to inadequate academic performance and non-academic reasons

The committee was apprised that as per the recommendations of the Academic Performance Evaluation Committee (APEC) academic programme of 79 students were terminated due to inadequate academic performance or any other reasons at the end of 2016-17-II semester. Out of 79 terminated students, 70 students had submitted their appeals for reinstatement.

In addition of that appeals of the following two students were received:

- Mr. Abhishek Ranjan (150041) academic program was terminated at the end of 2016-17-I semester due to inadequate academic performance but appeal was not submitted.
- Mr. Surav Nayak (161035) whose academic program was terminated due to unauthorized absence in 2016-17-II semester.

Appeals of 72 students were considered by the committee case-to-case basis. After due deliberation on each appeals and based on the academic performance of the students as well as recommendations of the DUGC and Counselling Service, it was decided that the recommendations of the SUGC will be sent to the Senate for its further consideration.
