MINUTES OF THE 1st MEETING OF THE SENATE ONLINE PROGRAMME COMMITTEE (2022-23)

Item 1. Request from Programs to change the eligibility criteria in SOPC manual. Currently we have:

Bachelor's degree (4 years program) or a Master's degree in appropriate discipline with at least 55% marks or 5.5/10 CPI + 2 years of work experience (an applicant need not be employed to be eligible). Candidates with relevant experience will be preferred.

Minutes: SOPC members were not in favor of changing the eligibility criteria.

Item 2. Timeline for addition of new programs:

- Full proposal should be received asap so that it can be sent to Senate.
- Ideally, application window will end in May first week, so must start advertising now.

Minutes: SOPC members agreed with the timeline.

Item 3. Name change of DMRM program to Quantitative Finance and Risk Management

Minutes: SOPC members accepted the name change and the same will be sent to Senate Chairman for approval.

Item 4. Conduct of online exams: requests have been received but suggestions needed on how to proceed

Minutes: SOPC members agreed to take it up and create a proposal to be submitted to Senate.

Item 5. New courses: if required, new courses must be floated via DOPC and send to SOPC for approval

Minutes: SOPC members agreed with the process.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
