It is **mandatory** for all registered students of IIT Kanpur to reside in the Halls of residence assigned to them.

Orientation Program:

The Orientation program is organized to acquaint the new students with the Institute and to facilitate a smooth transition into the new life at IIT Kanpur. The students are assisted to perform various Institute formalities like Academic registration, ID card making, Bank account opening etc. Also, the freshers are helped to adjust to the new life of IIT Kanpur campus through various activities and sessions organized during the Orientation program.

The Orientation program for the new undergraduate begins on July 23, 2017.

Mode of Payment:

- Amount against column 'D' in the above table can be paid through demand draft in favour of "Registrar, IIT Kanpur" payable at Kanpur.
- A **separate demand draft of ₹ 5000.00 towards Mess Caution deposit** (Refundable), over and above the above fee is to be paid to the allotted Hall of Residence.


Note:

- You should keep sufficient money (around ₹ 9,000.00 in cash) with you at the time of registration to be paid as Mess advance (if required by the Hall of Residence allotted to you)
