Guidelines for Poster Submission

Posters based on short papers on thematic areas related to all areas of energy economics, energy policy and regulation are invited. These may include (but not limited to) the following

- Power – Generation, Transmission and Distribution
- Regulatory and Policy Issues in Power Sector
- Regulatory and Policy Issues in Oil & Gas Sector
- Regulatory and Policy Issues in Coal Sector
- Renewable Energy Economics, policy and regulation
- Rural Electrification
- Energy Efficiency
- Energy Pricing
- Energy and Climate Changes
- Energy and Environment Policy Modelling
- Functioning of Energy Markets including Power Exchanges

Paper Format: Academically well references papers upto 5000 words may present the main objective, literature review, methodology and major results./conclusions. Papers could be formatted as per any of the standard journal formats. Papers should be typed in 1.5 line spacing with font-size 12.

Poster Presentation:

The outcome of the paper may be displayed in a single printed poster of size 3’ x 4’ or upto 8 sheets of A-4 size paper.

Venue of Poster Presentation:

Atrium, Outreach Auditorium, IIT Kanpur

Selection Procedure:

A technical committee would screen and select the posters from the submitted entries for poster presentation during the symposium. Based on the assessment of an award committee following three category of awards may be given,

- Platinum Prize
- Diamond Prize
- Golden Prize

The prizes may include a citation and certificates.
